Homework in Year 5

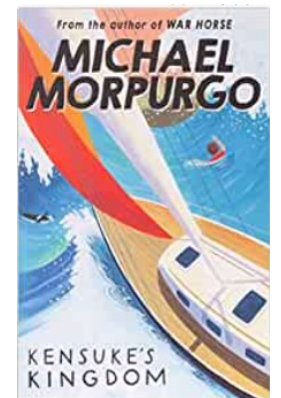
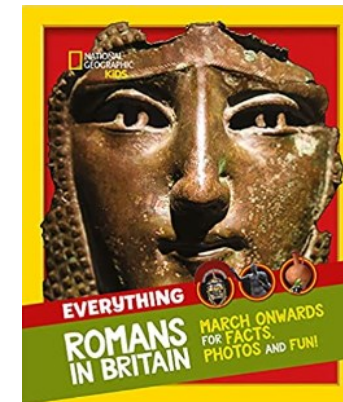
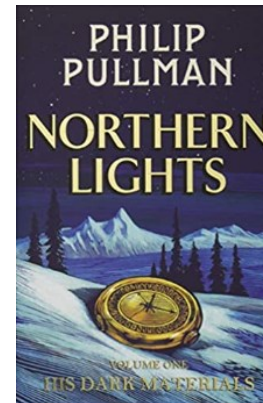

Homework will be celebrated each week with a 'homework hero' as well as a reading celebration in class.

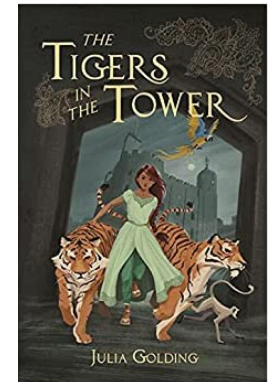
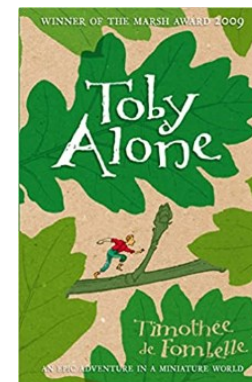
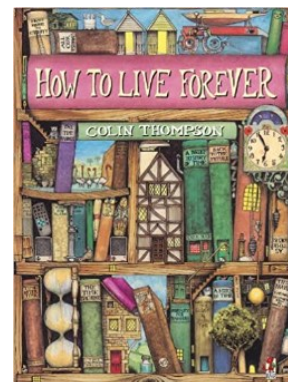

Welcome to Year 5!

Miss Kent and Miss Hodgson are delighted to be teaching year 5 this year and are looking forward to getting to know the children and supporting them on their learning journey.

Reading in Year 5

Our year group text is Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. We will study the text using a variety of reading skills including prediction, retrieval and inference to find out more about the characters and the setting.

Year 5 are encouraged to read at least three times a week and to have their reading diaries signed, which will be monitored on a daily basis. We will celebrate home reading on a weekly basis. Children will have the opportunity to change their home reading book once a week during our school library session.

Writing in Year 5

Year 5 will be focussing on setting descriptions, based around water safety and will use their everyday writing toolkit to create their own short narrative. The children will be encouraged to hook the reader by building tension and creating a strong sense of atmosphere using personification, similes and metaphors.

Maths in Year 5

We will begin our year 5 maths by looking in depth at numbers and the value of each digit. We will consolidate our understanding by rounding and comparing numbers.

The Reading Enhanced Curriculum in Year 5

Our first curriculum topic is history driven with a focus on the Romans and their impact on Britain. Our driving text is 'Everything Romans in Britain'. We will also be developing our geography skills by looking at different time zones and the location of capital cities.

Further Topics in Year 5 This Term

RE

During Autumn 1, the theme of our learning will be 'Inspirational people in today's world' within which we will look at people including Martin Luther King and Gandhi.

MUSIC

Year 5 are extremely fortunate as they will have a weekly ukulele lesson which will be taught by an external provider.

PSHE

We are beginning the year on a topic called 'Being Me' which focuses on providing children with the tool to face new challenges positively and understand how their behaviour can impact others.

MFL

This term, we will be continuing our Spanish lessons with a focus on units called 'My home'.

Computing

In computing, year 5 will begin by looking at how we can use the internet to find information and comparing different search engines.

PE

In Autumn term, year 5 will be learning basketball skills followed by fitness.
